- ~In these Scriptures are three references to either the Ethiopians, the region of Ethiopia, or the Eunuchs coming to know or worshiping God.
- I. Phillip left a revival in Samaria to travel 100 miles to the desert when the angel spoke to him
 - a. His response was obedience. He did not question God.
 - b. He had the heart of a disciple.
 - c. Would you have doubted God In this situation? How many miles of desert would it have taken you to say, "Lord, did I hear you correctly"?
- ~True disciples have the hearts of Abraham and Phillip. When God speaks they listen and obey; they do not question they just do.
 - II. Phillip's message to the Ethiopian was simple, but its doctrine was heavy
 - a. His message covered all ethnicities, cultures and classes
