- I. Hebrews 12:24~The Greek word for mediator is *mesites*. This word is used to mean three things in the Bible:
 - a. Reconciler, arbitrator, umpire
 - b. Jesus Christ is our mediator
 - c. In the Old Testament God used Moses as the mediator between Him and His people
 - d. Romans 11:22-23; Romans 11:32—mediating the Gentiles into the plan of salvation

 - a. God will chasten when men refuse to hear him
 - b. God will chasten when men commit iniquity
 - c. God will chasten when men provoke Him
 - d. God will chasten when men forsake Him
 - e. God will chasten when men refuse to judge themselves
 - f. God will chasten the stubborn and the rebel
 - g. God will chasten those who sow into the flesh
 - h. God will chasten those He seeks to instruct and care for
