**Primary Text: Revelation 19:11-16**

- I. Revelation 15:5
  - a. Revelation 15:5~“Testimony”-the truth, evidence, and proclamation of who God is with His people. This word matches the Hebrew word for “tabernacle.” This word (mishkan) is a symbol of God’s presence. The Word of God is a symbol of His presence in our life.
  
- II. Revelation 19:15
  - a. The Bible is the living, spoken word of God
  - b. The Word of God is a sharp sword; it is the sword of the Spirit
  - c. When Jesus return He is not coming to negotiate with people
  - d. Hebrews 4:12-the Word will pierce
